* Learning Agreement is a contract between the home university and the applicant and serves to determine the courses you will study at the host university.

You only need to complete the first section "Before the mobility". Table A defines the subjects and credits you will receive at the host university, table B defines which of the subjects of Table A will be recognized at University Metropolitan Tirana when you have completed the exchange period.

ATTENTION: You must choose to complete at University of Malaga, Spain the same courses that you would complete in the second semester of the academic year 2023/2024 in your faculty, so that the courses and credits will be recognized when come back If the selected subjects differ from those you would develop in your faculty, then when you return you must take the exam for the subjects are not recognised in University Metropolitan Tirana.

The "Learning Agreement" document in the "Commitment" section is signed by the applicant and then in the "sending university" section it is signed by the Head of the Department at UMT.

Deadline for applications: 30 October, 2023
