Duration of the Mobility:

Students will study during the second semester of the 2023-2024 academic year at the Alexandru Ioan Cuza University of Iași, Romania.

Who is eligible?

- UMT Bachelor Students studying in their second and third academic year;
- UMT Master students studying in their first and second academic year.

From:

- Faculty of Computer Science and IT;
- Faculty of Economics.

Language of Teaching:

The language of teaching will be in English.

The scholarship includes:

- Monthly compensation for students (800 EURO per month);
- Travel costs (depending on the distance between the host and home universities).

Documents for application

- 1. Copy of passport;
- 2. Transcript of records;
- 3. Proof of Enrolment;
- 4. Photocopy of Certificate/evidence of English language or document proving knowledge in this language. Required level B2;
- 5. Learning Agreement;
- * Learning Agreement is a contract between the home university and the applicant and serves to determine the courses you will study at the host university.

You only need to complete the first section "Before the mobility". Table A defines the subjects and credits you will receive at the host university, table B defines which of the subjects of Table A will be recognized at Universiteti Metropolitan Tirana when you have completed the exchange period.

ATTENTION: You must choose to complete at "Alexandru Ioan Cuza" University of Iași, Romania the same courses that you would complete in the second semester of the academic year 2023/2024 in your faculty, so that the courses and credits will be recognized when come back If the selected subjects differ from those you would develop in your faculty, then when you return you must take the exam for the subjects are not recognised in Universiteti Metropolitan Tirana.

The "Learning Agreement" document in the "Commitment" section is signed by the applicant and then in the "sending university" section it is signed by the Head of the Department at UMT.
