



Open Call for Student Applications under Erasmus+ Programme at the University College of Enterprise and Administration in Lublin, Poland

Duration of the Mobility:

Students will study at the University College of Enterprise and Administration in Lublin, Poland, during the second semester of the academic year 2023-2024.

Who is Eligible?

- UMT Bachelor Students studying in their second and third academic year;
- UMT Master students studying in their first and second academic year.

From:

- Faculty of Computer Science and IT;
- Faculty of Economics.

Language of Teaching:

The language of teaching will be in English.

The scholarships include:

- Monthly compensation for students (800 EUR per month);
- Travel costs (depending on the distance between the host and home universities).

Travel distance	Amount per participant
Between 10 and 99 Km	20 Euros
Between 100 and 499 km	180 Euros
Between 500 and 1999 km	275 Euros
Between 2000 and 2999 km	360 Euros
Between 3000 and 3999 km	530 Euros
Between 4000 and 7999 km	820 Euros
8000 km or more	1.500 Euros



Documents required for application:

- Certificate and Transcript of Records;
- Copy of Passport;
- Photocopy of Certificate/evidence of English language or document proving knowledge in this language. Minimum required level B1; If the internationally recognized certificate is missing, then get a certificate from the English language lecturer at UMT.;
- Learning Agreement *

** Learning Agreement is a contract between the home university and the applicant and serves to determine the courses you will study at the host university. You only need to complete the first section "Before the mobility. Table A defines the subjects and credits you will receive at the host university, table B defines which of the subjects of Table A will be recognized at Tirana Metropolitan University when you have completed the exchange period.*

ATTENTION: You must choose to complete at University College of Enterprise and Administration in Lublin, Poland the same courses that you would complete in the second semester of the academic year 2023-2024 in your faculty, so that the courses and credits will be recognized when come back. If the selected subjects differ from those you would develop in your faculty, then when you return you must take the exam for the subjects are not recognised in Universiteti Metropolitan Tirana.

The "Learning Agreement" document in the "Commitment" section is signed by the applicant and then in the "sending university" section it is signed by the Head of the Department at UMT.
