

Open Call for Student Applications under Erasmus+ Programme at the CY TECH University, France

Duration of the Mobility:

Students will study at the CY TECH, France during the first semester of the academic year 2024-2025.

Who is eligible?

UMT students who during the 2024-2025 academic year will be in the second and third year of bachelor and also students of the first and second year of master's from the following Faculties:

- Faculty of Engineering and Architecture
(Only students from the Civil Engineering can apply)
- Faculty of Computer Science and IT (bachelor and master);

Contact the International Relations Office regarding courses taught in English at the host university for the first semester.

Language of Teaching:

The language of teaching will be in English.

The scholarships include:

- Monthly compensation for students (850 EUR per month);
- Travel costs (depending on the distance between the host and home universities).

Documents required for application:

- Transcript of Records;
- Copy of Passport;
- Photocopy of Certificate/evidence of English language or document proving knowledge in this language. Minimum required level B1; If the internationally recognized certificate is missing, then get a certificate from the English language lecturer at UMT;
- Learning Agreement. *

** Learning Agreement is a contract between the home university and the applicant and serves to determine the courses you will study at the host university. You only need to complete the first*

section "Before the mobility". Table A defines the subjects and credits you will receive at the host university, table B defines which of the subjects of Table A will be recognized at University Metropolitan Tirana when you have completed the exchange period.

ATTENTION: You must choose to complete at the CY TECH, France the same courses that you would complete in the first semester of the academic year 2024/2025 in your faculty, so that the courses and credits will be recognized when come back. If the selected subjects differ from those you would develop in your faculty, then when you return you must take the exam for the subjects are not recognised in University Metropolitan Tirana.

The "Learning Agreement" document in the "Commitment" section is signed by the applicant and then in the "sending university" section it is signed by the Head of the Department at UMT.
