



Open Call for Student Applications in the framework of Erasmus+ Programme at the University of Granada, Spain

Duration of the Mobility:

Students will study at the University of Granada, Spain, during the second semester of the academic year 2024-2025.

Who is eligible?

All UMT students who during the 2024-2025 academic year will be in the:

- II and III year of Bachelor
- I and II year of Masters

Language of Teaching:

Teaching is offered in Spanish (all programs) and English (some study programs).

The scholarships include:

- Monthly compensation for students (850 EUR per month);
- Travel costs (depending on the distance between the host and home universities).

Documents required for application:

- Certificate and Transcript of Records;
- Copy of Passport;
- Photocopy of the English or Spanish language certificate. Students who will be studying in Spanish must have a certificate of this language. Students who will be studying in English must have an English language certificate.

Candidates who are in the process of obtaining the language certificate are requested to submit proof of registration.

- Learning Agreement.

** Learning Agreement is a contract between the home university and the applicant and serves to determine the courses you will study at the host university. You only need to fill in the first section "Before the mobility. Table A defines the courses and credits that will take at the host university, Table B defines which of the subjects in Table A will be recognized at University Metropolitan Tirana when you have completed the exchange mobility period.*

ATTENTION: You must choose to complete at the University of Granada the same subjects as those that you would choose at your faculty, so that the courses and credits will be recognized when you return. If the selected subjects differ from those you would develop in your faculty, then when you return, you have to take the exam in the subjects that are not recognized at University Metropolitan Tirana.
