





Open Call for Student Applications under Erasmus+ Programme at the University of Lodz, Poland

Duration of the Mobility:

Students will study at the Universitry of Lodz, Poland during the second semester of the academic year 2024-2025.

Who is eligible?

UMT students who during the 2024-2025 academic year will be in the second year of bachelor and also students of the first year of master's from the following Faculties:

- Faculty of Economics (bachelor and master);
- Faculty of Computer Science and IT (bachelor and master);

***Please note that the student cannot undertake mobility during his/her last study semester!

Language of teaching:

The language of teaching will be in English.

The scholarships include:

- Monthly compensation for students (800 EUR per month);
- Travel costs (depending on the distance between the host and home universities).

Documents required for application:

- Application form (word and pdf.)
- Certificate and transcript of the current study cycle;
- Copy of passport;
- Certificate/evidence of English language or document proving knowledge in this language. Required level B2
- Motivational Letter;
- Preliminary Learning Agreement;
- Scanned copy of the last school/educational certificate or degree obtained.







* Learning Agreement is a contract between the home university and the applicant and serves to

determine the courses you will study at the host university. You only need to complete the first section "Before the mobility". Table A defines the subjects and credits you will receive at the host university, table B defines which of the subjects of Table A will be recognized at university Metropolitan Tirana when you have completed the exchange period.

ATTENTION: You must choose to complete at the University of Lodz, Poland the same courses that you would complete in the second semester of the academic year 2024/2025 in your faculty, so that the courses and credits will be recognized when come back If the selected subjects differ from those you would develop in your faculty, then when you return you must take the exam for the subjects are not recognised in University Metropolitan Tirana.

The "Learning Agreement" document in the "Commitment" section is signed by the applicant and then in the "sending university" section it is signed by the Head of the Department at UMT.
