





Open Call for Student Applications under Erasmus+ Programme at Kodolányi János University, Hungary

Duration of the Mobility:

Students will study at Kodolányi János University, Hungary during the first semester of the academic year 2025-2026.

Who is eligible?

UMT students who during the 2025-2026 academic year will be in the second and third year of bachelor and also students of the first and second year of master's from the following Faculty:

- Faculty of Economics

Language of Teaching:

The language of teaching will be in English.

The scholarships include:

- Monthly compensation for students (800 EUR per month);
- Travel costs (depending on the distance between the host and home universities).

Documents required for application:

- Copy of Passport
- Transcript of Records;
- Photocopy of Certificate/proof of English language or document proving knowledge in this language. Required level B2; If there is no internationally recognized certificate then receive a certificate from the English language Professor at UMT.
- Learning Agreement *

^{*} Learning Agreement is a contract between the home university and the applicant and serves to determine the courses you will study at the host university. You only need to complete the first section "Before the mobility. Table A defines the subjects and credits you will receive at the host







university, table B defines which of the subjects of Table A will be recognized at University Metropolitan Tirana when you have completed the exchange period.

ATTENTION: You must choose to complete at the Kodolányi János in Hungary, the same courses that you would complete in the first semester of the academic year 2025/2026 in your faculty, so that the courses and credits will be recognized when back. If the selected subjects differ from those you would develop in your faculty, then when you return you must take the exam for the subjects that are not recognised at UMT.

The "Learning Agreement" document in the "Commitment" section is signed by the applicant and then in the "sending university" section it is signed by the Head of the Department at UMT.
