Language of Teaching:

The language of teaching will be in English.

The scholarship includes:

- Individual support for students in the amount of 900€/month.
- Travel support, you can use the EACEA online tool to calculate the distance.

Travel distance	Amount per participant
Between 10 and 99 Km	20 Euros
Between 100 and 499 km	180 Euros
Between 500 and 1999 km	275 Euros
Between 2000 and 2999 km	360 Euros
Between 3000 and 3999 km	530 Euros
Between 4000 and 7999 km	820 Euros
8000 km or more	1.500 Euros



Documents for application:

1. Copy of passport
2. Transcript of records
3. Proof of Enrolment
4. Certificate of English
5. Learning Agreement

** Learning Agreement is a contract between the home university and the applicant and serves to determine the courses you will study at the host university.*

You only need to complete the first section "Before the mobility". Table A defines the subjects and credits you will receive at the host university; table B defines which of the subjects of Table A will be recognized at University Metropolitan Tirana when you have completed the exchange period.

ATTENTION: You must choose to complete at Linnaeus University the same courses that you would complete in the first semester of the academic year 2026/2027 in your faculty, so that the courses and credits will be recognized upon your return. If the selected subjects differ from those you would develop in your faculty, then when you return you must take the exam for the subjects are not recognized at University Metropolitan Tirana.

The "Learning Agreement" document in the "Commitment" section is signed by the applicant and then in the "sending university" section it is signed by the Head of the Department at UMT.
