

Open Call for Student Applications in the framework of Erasmus+ Programme at the University of Warmia and Mazury in Olsztyn, Poland

Duration of Mobility:

Students will study the University of Warmia and Mazury in Olsztyn, Poland during the first semester of the academic year 2026-2027.

Who is eligible?

UMT students who, during the 2026–2027 academic year, will be enrolled in the second or third year of Bachelor studies, as well as students in the first or second year of Master studies, from the following faculty and study programs are eligible to apply:

- Faculty of Engineering and Architecture

****Only students from the Civil Engineering study program can apply.*

Language of Teaching

The language of teaching will be in English.

The scholarships include:

- Monthly compensation for students (800 EUR per month);
- Travel costs (depending on the distance between the host and home universities).

Documents required for application:

- Copy of Passport
- Certificate and Transcript of Records;
- Learning Agreement ***

**** Learning Agreement is a contract between the home university and the applicant and serves to determine the courses you will study at the host university. You only need to complete the first section "Before the mobility. Table A defines the subjects and credits you will receive at the host university, table B defines which of the subjects of Table A will be recognized at Universiteti Metropolitan Tirana when you have completed the exchange period.*

ATTENTION: You must choose to complete at the hosting university the same courses that you would complete in the first semester of the academic year 2026/2027 in your faculty, so that the courses and credits will be recognized when come back. If the selected subjects differ from those you would develop in your faculty, then when you return you must take the exam for the subjects are not recognised at Universiteti Metropolitan Tirana.

The "Learning Agreement" document in the "Commitment" section is signed by the applicant and then in the "sending university" section it is signed by the Head of the Department at UMT.

Application deadline: 5th of June, 2026
